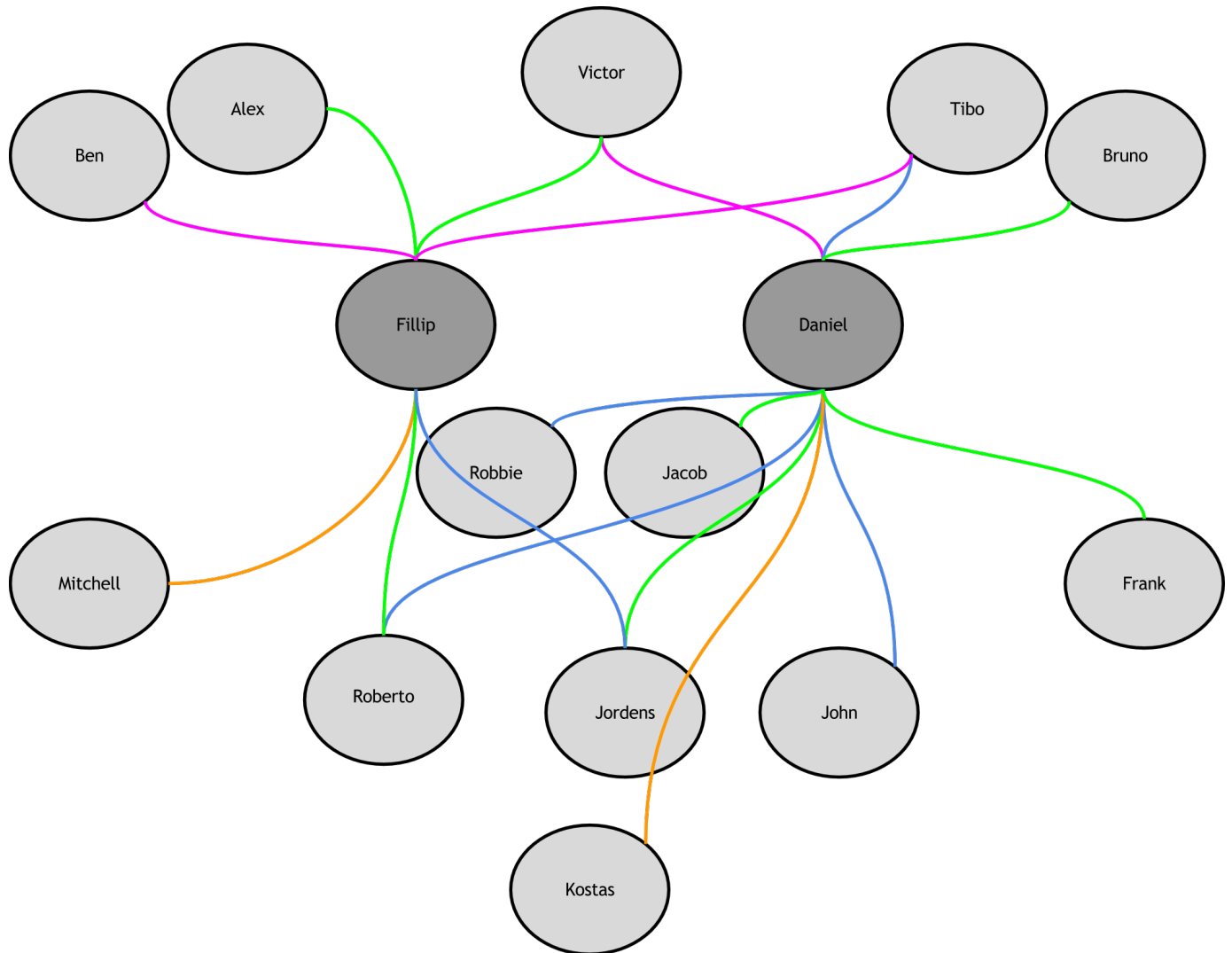




Comparison connectives

For the analysis used 15 players who often playing in the first team. Number of players and position can be changed, if necessary.



Explanation for connective types:

Defensive - quick interaction with a partner. Especially good working for defensive actions.	/
Dissonance - uncontrollable interaction, bad for defence.	o
Universal - good interaction and complementarity. This connective works in both defense and in attack. Recommended more practice with such teammates.	
Attack - creative interaction. Works well while attack.	^
Non - not connected psychotypes	

Consequence

Fillip has better connectives in attack line and not too much in defensive line. Daniel has good connectives in defensive and mid line, but attack line not so good with him as with Phillip. If you choose between two player for same position (attacking midfield) then Phillip has better chances to give an impulse for teammates. If you want both player play together, then Daniel should play more defensive midfield position and Phillip more attacking midfield.
